



MAKING VBS A safe experience:

Creating a safe environment is key to ensuring that kids have a fun and positive experience at VBS. Parents, volunteers, and church staff work together to give every child a safe place to learn and grow.

Guidelines for Interacting with Children

- Children are treated with respect; the same is expected from them.
- Class Leaders and Helpers are responsible for each child in their group.
 - 💡 Try taking a head count every time you move to a new site.
 - 💡 Consider assigning 4-6 kids to each helper as a “small group”.
- To avoid even the appearance of impropriety:
 - 💡 Two volunteers should be present at all times when working with children.
 - 💡 No volunteer may be alone with children, especially in the restroom or when moving to different areas.
 - 💡 Never send children to the restroom or another area alone or with other children.
- Children should only be released to adults listed on the registration form and in the way listed.
